Building Permits

Building permits versus planning permits
 Building permits are issued under the *Building Act 1993*, with planning permits being under the *Planning and Environment Act 1987*.

Generally, building permits are needed when constructing any new building or changing an existing building. In some cases a building permit is needed when you are constructing a fence or large shed. A planning permit may or may not be required when building (refer to the planning section of our website for more information on planning permits).


Building permit services

We offer a comprehensive building permit service, which includes compulsory inspections and the issuing of a final inspection certificate or occupancy permit. Council's prices are competitive and are in line with the recommended fee schedule adopted by the Australian Institute of Building Surveyors.

On Display Indefinitely

Point Russell Governance Local Law 2013 (Local Law No.1 of 2013) is made under Part 5 section 111 of the

The objectives of the Local Law are to:

1. Regulate proceedings at Council meetings, Committee meetings and other meetings conducted by or on behalf of Council where Council has resolved that the provisions of the Local Law are to apply.
2. Regulate proceedings for the election of the Mayor, Deputy Mayor (if any) and Chairpersons of various Committees
3. Regulate the use of the common seal
4. Prohibit unauthorised use of the common seal or any device resembling the common seal
5. Make provision for related administrative procedures
6. Provide for peace, order and good government of the municipal district.
